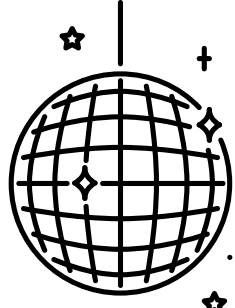

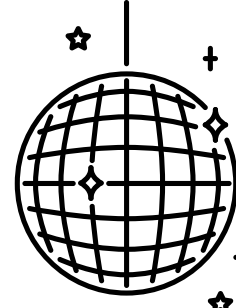

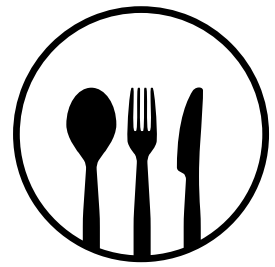
WE ALSO HAD APPLE BOBBING AT OUR COUNTRY THEMED PARTY AND I HAD TO INCLUDE THE PIC.

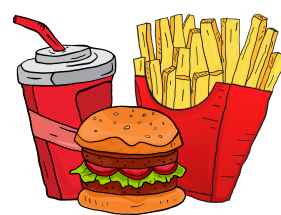


# NEW FALL MENU
