The same outstanding officer corps that led the membership last Spring will do so right through Bicker '26. We will continue to introduce them to you by video in these newsletters. In early 2026, we will be starting our major construction project, which we have been calling **Thrive in '25!** This significant expansion of our dining room and kitchen is absolutely necessary to accommodate the current membership, and they are extremely excited about it. We've made so much progress:

December '24	Architect selected; contract signed
January '25	Land surveys and subsurface testing complete
February '25	Schematic Design Phase
April '25	Estimate & Estimate Review
May '25	Value Engineering to keep design and budget on track
July '25	Design & Plans complete
August '25	Site Plan Review package submitted to Town for review and public hearings

And while we wait for the municipality to finish their review, which can take up to 100 days, we need your help. We are 60% to our goal of \$1.5 million, thanks to a few major donors and many, many smaller ones, all of which we very much appreciate. But 60% of the money will not get us out of the ground! We need to raise the other \$600,000 by the end of 2025. It's really not a big number if all 5000+ of our Cannon, Dial Lodge, Elm, DEC and CDE alumni were to make even a small contribution.
